Dear Mr. Pred, Mr. Vuthy and Ms. Pilorge,

Thank you for your letter of November 2, 2020.

The Coca- Cola company is not sourcing and has never sourced sugar from Cambodia.

The Coca-Cola Company's respect for human rights – as outlined in our <u>Human Rights Policy</u>, <u>Supplier Guiding Principles</u> and <u>Sustainable Agriculture Guiding Principles</u> – is aligned with the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights.

We expect our suppliers to abide by our Supplier Guiding Principles and note the supplier in this instance has exited Cambodia and undertaken other remedial action. However, we will continue to engage the supplier as they work towards resolution with the local communities.

As the matter is currently before the courts it would not be appropriate to comment further at this time.
